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Purpose

- To provide Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) and other entities with guidance for testing and submitting production data to the Encounter Data System (EDS).

MAOs and Other Entities

- CMS requires the following types of organizations to submit encounter data:
 - Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans
 - Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug (MA-PD) Plans
 - Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
 - Special Needs Plans (SNPs)
 - Local Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
 - Regional PPOs
 - Employer Group Health Plans
 - Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) Plans
 - Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
 - Medical Savings Account (MSA) Plans
 - Private Fee-for-Service (PFFS) Plans
 - Religious Fraternal Benefit (RFB) Plans
 - Provider Sponsored Organizations (PSOs)

CMS Updates



MAO-002 Reports Update

- The EDPS is currently processing MAO-002 Reports for data received on May 21, 2013.
- If you have not received your MAO-002 Reports for files submitted prior to May 21, 2013, please contact CSSC Operations at (877) 534-2772, with your file information, for assistance.

Submission Frequency

- CMS will use the February 2013 Health Plan Management System (HPMS) contract enrollment data to determine submission frequency requirements for each MAO or other entity.
- It is recommended that MAOs and other entities adhere to the submission frequency based on the February 2013 HPMS enrollment data.

Number of Medicare Enrollees	Minimum Submission Frequency
Greater than 100,000	Weekly
50,000 – 100,000	Bi-weekly
Less than 50,000	Monthly

EDS Operational Highlights

Highlight #1

Discontinuation of HH Type of Bill 33X

- Effective for Home Health episodes beginning on or after October 1, 2013, CMS will no longer accept Institutional encounters submitted with TOB 33X – Home Health Services Under a Plan of Treatment.

Highlight #1

Discontinuation of HH Type of Bill 33X (cont'd)

- MAOs and other entities that submit TOB 33X for Institutional encounters will receive the following CEM reject edit on their returned 277CA Acknowledgement Reports:

Edit Reference	Edit Description	Edit Notes
X223.150.2300.DTP03.030	CSCC A7: "Acknowledgement /Rejected for Invalid Information..." CSC 228: "Type of bill for UB claim"	Proposed 5010 Edit: If the 2300.DTP03 (DTP01 = "434") "FROM" date is on or after October 1, 2013, 2300.CLM05-1 must not = "33"

Highlight #2

13-Month Timely Filing Guidance

- In an effort to collect complete 2012 data, CMS has determined that no edits related to the 13-month timely filing rule will be applied at this time.
- MAOs and other entities should continue to monitor EDPS Bulletins and EDS Quarterly Newsletters, and attend bi-weekly EDS User Group sessions for information regarding updates to this decision.

Highlight #3

HIPPS Code Edits

- MAOS and other entities must begin submitting Health Insurance Prospective Payment System (HIPPS) data for all Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) and Home Health (HH) encounters effective for July 1, 2013 Dates of Service (DOS) and beyond.
- HH encounters must be submitted using the 837-Institutional format.

Highlight #3

HIPPS Code Edits (cont'd)

- Beginning with July 1, 2013 DOS, MAOs and other entities will receive an informational edit for SNF and HH encounters submitted without HIPPS codes.
- MAOs and other entities will also receive an informational edit for Home Health encounters submitted in the 837-Professional format instead of the required 837-Institutional format.

Highlight #3

HIPPS Code Edit (cont'd)

- Effective as of December 1, 2013 DOS, the disposition for these edits will be changed from 'Informational' to 'Reject' for any SNF and HH encounters submitted without the appropriate HIPPS codes or that are submitted in the 837-Professional format.
- MAOs and other entities are expected to communicate the HIPPS code requirements with SNF and HH providers so that they are able to make any changes to their systems, etc.

Highlight #4

999 Report Naming Conventions

- Due to a technical issue, the naming convention was changed for the 999 Acknowledgement Reports that are submitted to File Transfer Protocol (FTP) users' mailboxes.
- Effective immediately, the new naming convention is as follows:

Report Type	FTP Mailbox - Old	FTP Mailbox - New
999	999xxxxx.RSP	999#####.999.999

Highlight #5

NDM GDGs

- If there are not enough Generated Data Groups (GDGs) established on the system for the Network Data Mover (NDM)/Connect:Direct submitter's system to meet the number of files being received from EDFES, the reports will not be stored on the submitter's system.
- The reports appear on the EDFES system to have been received by the submitter.

Highlight #5

NDM GDGs (cont'd)

- The reports appear to be missing, or not received on the submitter's system.
- To prevent this situation, NDM/Connect:Direct submitters should establish a limit of 255 GDGs on their systems.

Highlight #6

Report Restoration

- 999 and 277CA Acknowledgement Reports will not be restored if the files are older than 20 days.
- MAO Reports will not be restored if the files are older than 60 days.
- Requests for more than 200 files will not be accepted.

MAO Reports Layouts

MAO Reports Layouts

- The EDPS MAO Reports are currently delivered to submitters in two (2) forms:
 1. Flat file – A delimited text file that provides detailed header and line level descriptions of the encounter’s processing status.
 2. Formatted file – A text file that allows MAOs and other entities to identify and review the encounter’s status based on identified fields.

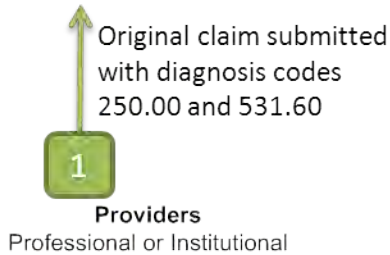
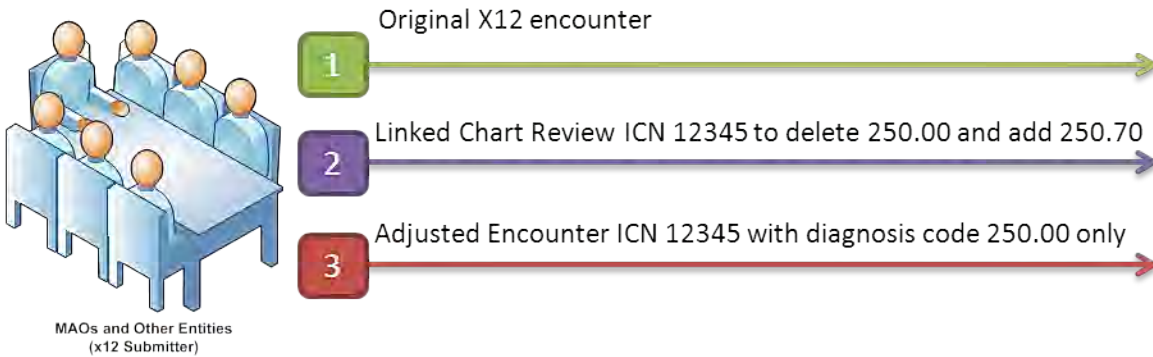

Request for Industry Feedback

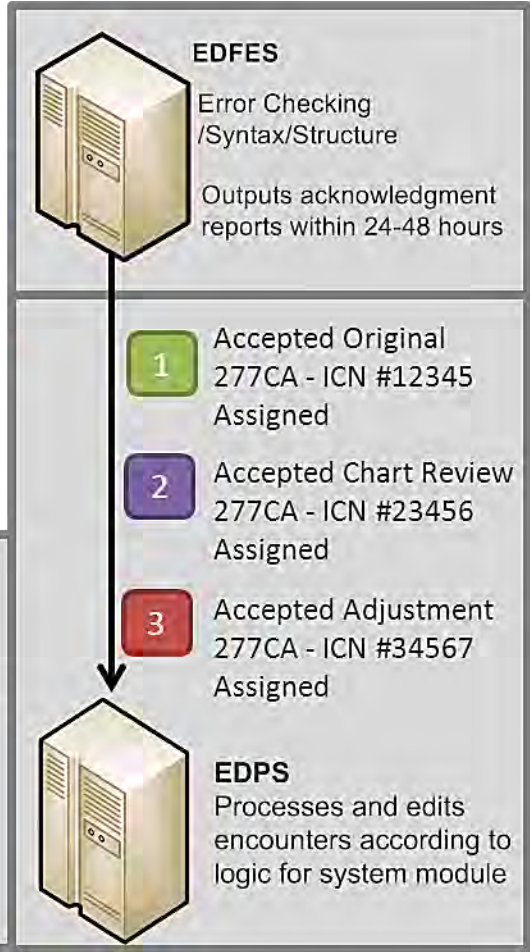

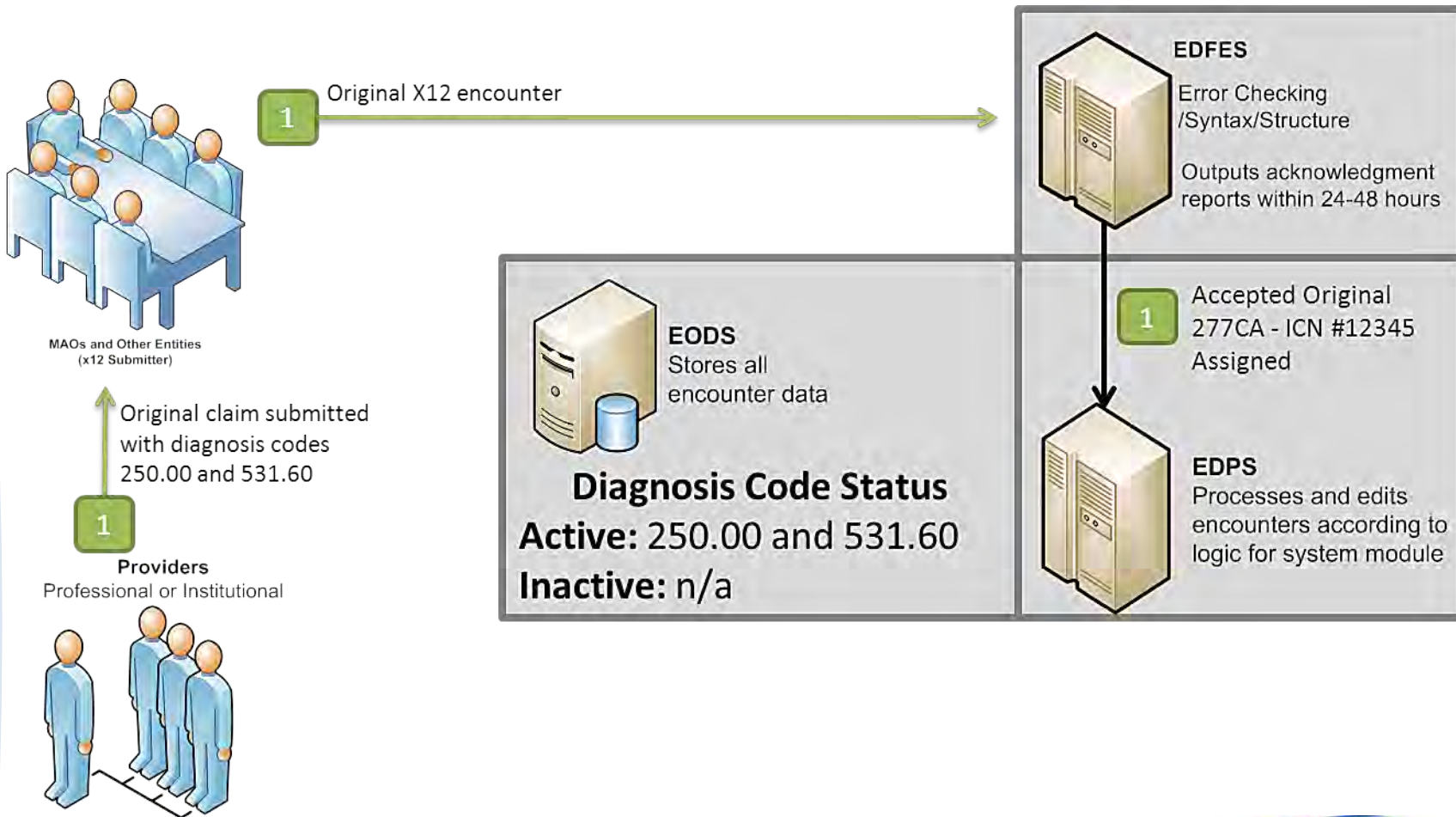
Encounter Adjustment After Linked Chart Review Scenario



Which diagnosis codes are stored in the EODS and associated with the encounter?



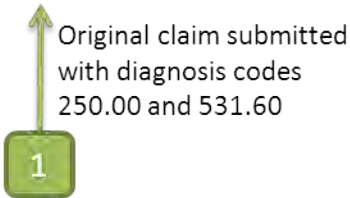
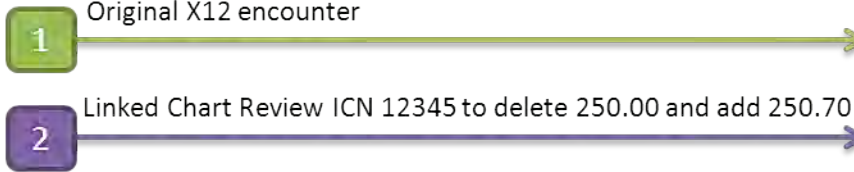

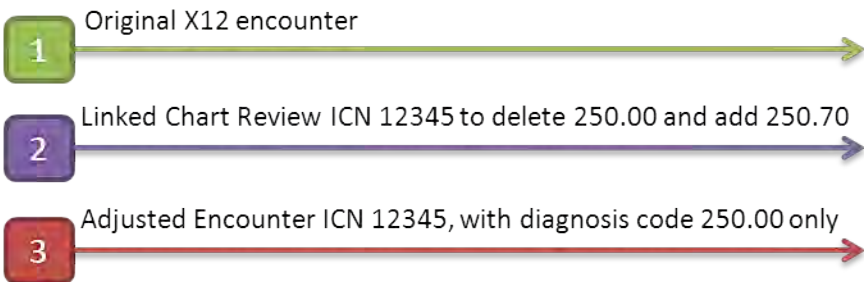

- Therefore, MAOs and other entities should also submit an adjustment to the Chart Review.

Chart Review Deletion

Chart Review Deletion

- If the MAO or other entity submits a Chart Review for one diagnosis and a subsequent Chart Review indicates that the diagnosis should not have been submitted, and there is no diagnosis code to replace it:
 - The MAO or other entity should submit a Void/Delete Chart Review encounter with CLM05-3=8.


